#### LOOKING AHEAD - WHAT'S NEXT FOR BEECHWOOD VILLAGE?

Following our recent letter to nearby residents about the demolition of some existing homes on Beechwood Village, works are now happening and you will have noticed some hoarding fencing has already been put up.

Once the existing properties have been removed, we will then start to prepare the land and build foundations for the next new homes, beginning in Spring 2022.

While all possible measures will be taken to minimise disruption, as with all works of this type, there may be some limited noise, dust and vibrations during working hours.

We will monitor the noise and vibration levels carefully to ensure that disruption is monitored and minimal. Should you have any concerns about the works during this time, please contact Shona McKinnon, Development Manager, on smckinnon@swan.org.uk

### **BEECHWOOD VILLAGE COMMUNITY GARDEN - THANK YOU!**

A big thank you to all of our residents from Beechwood Village who recently joined us, along with Axis team members and Beechwood Community Trust, to begin the makeover of the Beechwood Village Community Garden.

Fuelled by toasties and crepes from the Tin Canteen, the team of green-fingered volunteers worked throughout the day to the rhythm of the Pantasy Steel band. Together we made fantastic progress with the community garden.

More than 50 large bags of green waste were collected throughout the day. The area is now much more manageable for our Estates team to work on,

with the support of the local community. Spring bulbs will be planted on Tuesday 21 December, ready to flower early in 2022.

The area is now ready for the 'Backyard Nature' project, fun and free nature-based activities such as planting 'wild seed balls' to protect the bees and building bug hotels, which starts later this year.


